The Challenge

In 2019, Northern Illinois University Graduate School began offering a new course, UNIV 602, Career Preparation for the Job Market, to assist students with transitioning from graduate school into a chosen occupation. Given today's competitive job market, the university recognized the value of a curriculum specifically designed to support students' career preparation. Framed by real-time market analytics, UNIV 602 helps students target their job searches and improve their chances of beginning a successful career path. In addition to helping each student develop their own Job Market Plan, the course focuses on composing cover letters and resumes, selecting application materials, and developing interviewing skills. When Dean Bradley Bond began searching for interviewing practice software to include in the course, he hoped to find a robust video-based platform that would integrate into the current curriculum and provide easy, self-guided interviewing practice and evaluation. He also wanted a platform that would be both customizable and scalable. According to Dean Bond, "We wanted the ability to create an interview protocol and then scale up in response to each student." What he found exceeded his expectations.

The Solution

"As soon as we looked into StandOut, we understood it was more impressive than anything else on the market," Dean Bond remarked. "The bank of questions, the ability to customize questions, and the AI speech recognition all blew us away. It

Customizable and Scalable

According to Dr. Wilkins: "StandOut enables us to customize interview question protocols, so we can start with common questions and then go to more individualized, program-specific and behavioral-specific questions. Having the flexibility to create interviews tailored to a student's program area is extremely valuable. Then, we can move on to behavioral questions, problem-solving questions, and so on, later in the course. StandOut's advanced cognitive computing and AI provide students a comprehension score based on the words and phrases used in their responses. Students really appreciate having the comprehension score as a goal-setting tool. We're finding it's invaluable pronunciation practice for international students.

"I have to say the platform is intuitive and quick to learn – easy for students and advisors to navigate," Dr. Wilkins added. "Our students have the ability to re-record and watch their practice interviews; they can reflect on and share their responses with me, as well as invite feedback from their peers. Feedback can include verbal or written commentary about eye contact, distracting mannerisms, clarity of speech, answering all parts of a question, and so on. This kind of experience boosts students' confidence, helps them learn to speak clearly, and succinctly, and to elaborate effectively. They tell me StandOut interviewing practice is their favorite part of the course."
